
The Airport Limousine Company runs several shuttle buses each day between the hotel and Narita Airport adult:3,000yen, child:1,500yen (6 - 12years)



From Haneda Airport

It is not recommendable to take Airport Limousine bus from Haneda Airport since it runs only one bus a day and takes longer time than other transportation means. adult:900yen, child:450yen (6 - 12years)

It is only 18-minute train ride from Haneda Airport station to Hamamatsucho station via the Tokyo Monorail express train. It is 8-minute walk from Hamamatsucho station (see below) Or you may choose to take a taxi which is only 30-minutes' drive from Haneda airport to the hotel.

From JR Hamamatsucho station, North exit, and Tokyo Monorail (8-minute walk) Go towards Tokyo Tower and turn right at the third traffic light (in front of the big Japanese-style gate)

From Daimon station on the Toei Oedo/Toei Asakusa line (4-minute walk.)

Go out the A6 exit, walk toward Zojoji Temple, and turn right at the first corner (in front of the big Japanese-style gate)

From Onarimon station on the Toei Mita line (2-minute walk.)

Go out the A2 exit, walk down Hibiya Dori toward Zojoji Temple, and turn left at the first traffic signal

From JR Tokyo station

15 minutes by taxi 6-minute train ride to Hamamatsucho station (3 stops) via the JR Yamanote line. 8-minute walk from Hamamatsucho station (see above)

From Tokyo City Air Terminal (TCAT)

15 minutes by taxi

8-minute train ride from Ningyocho station to Daimon station on the Toei Asakusa subway line. 4-minute walk from Daimon station (see above)
